

Birthday Party FAQ's

What is the difference between the Traditional Party and the Bounce and Beyond Party?

Bounce parties add the 3 inflatables, get plates, forks, cups, napkins, a glow-in-the-dark cup and a pencil for each child, and a t-shirt for the birthday child.

Can I get just one inflatable?

Yes, add \$25 for each inflatable.

Will I have the gym exclusively?

This is not guaranteed. At times, we have private lessons or workouts on the other side of the gym. They will do the best they can to give us all of the equipment that birthday parties use, understanding that parties do get priority.

Will the gym time be supervised?

Yes, there will be one adult gymnastics professional in the gym at all times, plus one or two helpers.

Which guests count in the 20 guests included in the price?

Any child that actually plays on the equipment counts as a guest.

Can adults go on the equipment?

No, because of liability issues, adults are not allowed to use the equipment. Adults enter the gym at their own risk. Please advise all of your guests of this. They are allowed to come in the gym to help their child or take pictures, as long as they have soft soled clean shoes. High heels, dirty shoes, food, beverages other than water, and gum are not allowed in the gym.

What if a child misbehaves?

For the first offense, the child will be given a 2-minute time-out. The second offense brings a 5-minute time-out. The third offense results in expulsion from the gym. The child will have to wait in the party room with an adult. Types of misbehavior that would warrant restriction include anything that could create a dangerous environment for the guests, not obeying the gym rules, or not listening to the staff.

Do the parents need to sign a waiver?

No, since they're not going on the equipment.

What can I bring to the party room?

You can bring anything legal: food, beverages, decorations, piñatas.

Do I have to clean the party room?

No, our staff will clean at your designated departure time.

Can I get in the party room to set up right away?

All parties will get 25 minutes before their **party room** time to set up the party room. Since the parties overlap, the party room will be occupied when you arrive, and will NOT be available. Please see the schedule below.

Can I get extra time in the gym or in the party room?

Extra time usually does not fit into the schedule below. On occasions, it can be arranged. Contact the party director.
